

Durasein® ROHS Compliance Statement

European Directive 2011/65/EU on the “Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in electrical and electronic equipment” (“RoHS Directive”) as amended by Directive (EU) 2015/863, also known as RoHS3, originated in the European Union and restricts the use of specific hazardous materials found in electrical and electronic products (known as EEE).

Durasein® is committed to the safety and health of our employees, customers, contractors and to the sustainability and protection of the environment. Durasein® does not use or intentionally incorporate into Durasein® Solid Surface any of the prohibited substances which are listed in the **RoHS3 Directive**.

RoHS specifies maximum levels by weight for the following 10 restricted materials:

- Cadmium (Cd): < 100 ppm (0.01%)
- Lead (Pb): < 1000 ppm (0.1%)
- Mercury (Hg): < 1000 ppm (0.1%)
- Hexavalent Chromium (Cr VI) < 1000 ppm (0.1%)
- Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB): < 1000 ppm (0.1%)
- Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE): < 1000 ppm (0.1%)
- Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP): < 1000 ppm (0.1%) (RoHS 3)
- Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP): < 1000 ppm (0.1%) (RoHS 3)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP): < 1000 ppm (0.1%) (RoHS 3)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP): < 1000 ppm (0.1%) (RoHS 3)
