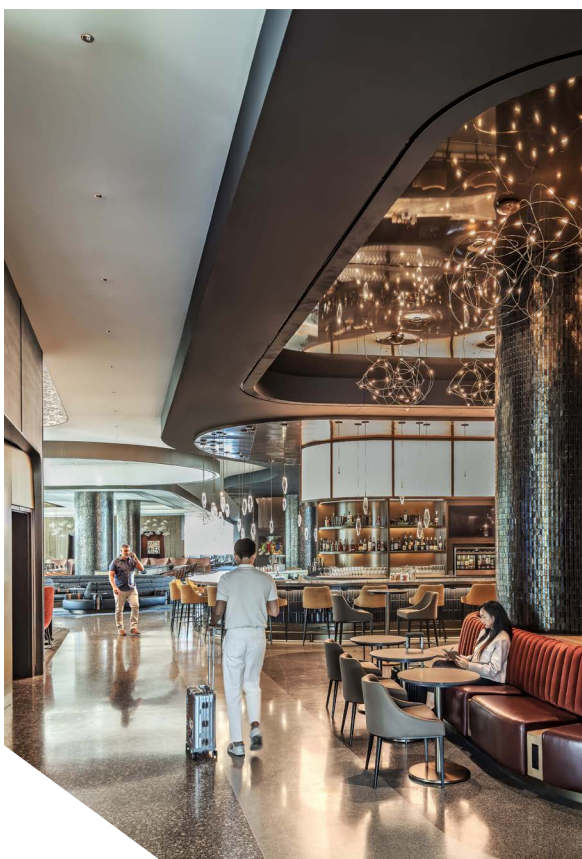

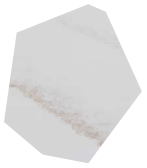
The Challenge

HOK was designing a 34,000-square-foot Delta Sky Club at Salt Lake City International Airport. Their vision was a warm, inviting lounge where visitors could escape the chaos of the airport and immerse themselves in the spectacular beauty of Utah's natural features and national parks.

With open hours 365 days a year and a capacity of 600 guests, the lounge would experience heavy traffic and constant use. This made the choice of materials crucial to its success. The architect needed to specify surfaces that resist wear and tear, prevent the spread of microbes, and clean up easily so they could continue to look their best for every guest.

Materials

HOK selected Durasein Solid Surface for the buffet island in the food service area. They chose Sun Kissed, capturing the pure clean color of Utah's snowy peaks, streaked with marbled bronze veins. Unlike real marble, this material is non-porous and resists scratches and stains. It's also microbe-resistant, and food-safe, making it an ideal material for countertops in high-traffic areas. Aesthetically, the solid surface material complements the jewel-toned upholstery, metallic ceiling and columns, and warm wood tones on the floors and furniture.



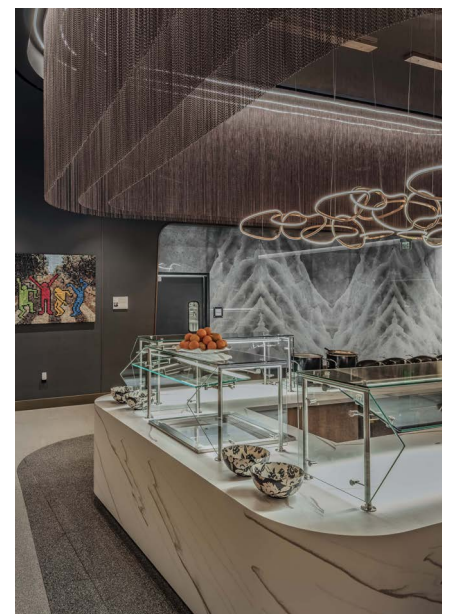
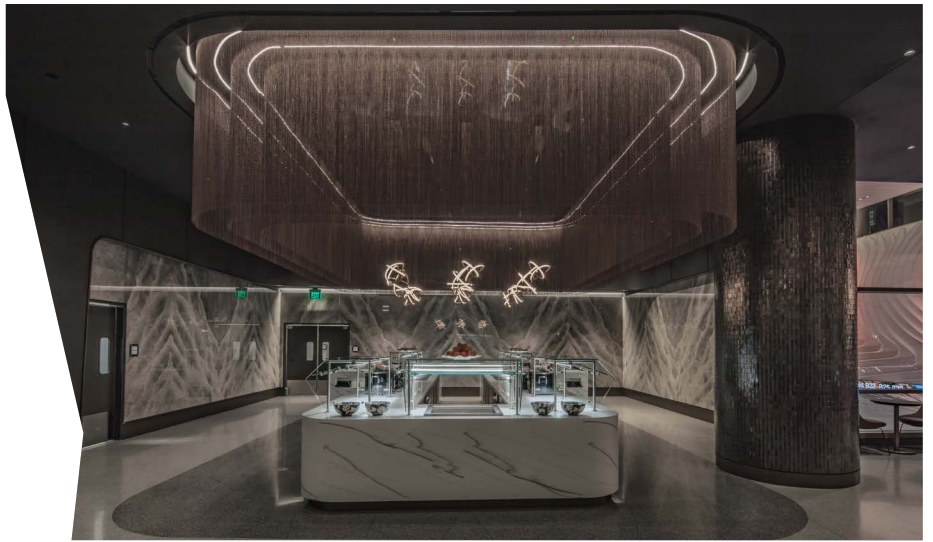

The Result

The Sky Club lounge takes guests on a journey through Utah's wonders. It begins with the glimmering ice-like accents and mosaic flooring in the entryway, moving on to waving metal chain drapery and West-inspired artwork at the escalators. On the main floor, a selection of lounges provide spaces for travelers to rest, work, or converse. One features floor-to-ceiling views of the stunning Wasatch and Oquirrh mountain range just past the runway. Guests can cozy up to the 360-degree fireplace, beneath a sparkling metal ceiling inspired by Utah's famous Great Salt Lake.

The bar and dining areas replicate Utah's caves and starry skies. Shimmering lights and reflective ceilings make up the expansive C-shaped bar, and richly veined Durasein Solid Surface provided the ideal medium for shaping the buffet island into smooth, seamless curves.

Another lounge surrounds guests with seven screens featuring the state's landmarks, along with velvet drapery, a rippling acoustic baffle ceiling, and peaceful nature sounds to create a soothing atmosphere.
